n September 2001 the Black Eyed Peas¹ were in California working on preliminary recordings for "Elephunk", their third album, when the 9/11 attacks on New York's World Trade Center happened. This greatly affected their songwriting, as they attempted² to crossover³ from being an alternative hip hop group to reaching a wider audience as a more marketable 4 pop-rap act 5. In an interview founding member will.i.am said the emotions in Where Is The Love? are from that time, when he created a loop⁶ over and he and his two bandmates wrote lyrics, each performing his own verse. The chorus is by Justin Timberlake, although his record company refused to allow him to be credited7.

The song is a reflection on social injustice in the world, and is almost entirely in the present tense. It begins with will.i.am's condemnation of domestic terror-

ism, discrimination and hate. The chorus⁸, by Timberlake and new band member Fergie, is a plea⁹ for a better world, before the second verse, by Taboo, laments chemical warfare 10 and the profits 11 of war. The final verse, by apl.de.ap, expresses the rapper's disillusionment with capitalism and fake news.

Released in 2003, the song propelled 12 the Black Eyed Peas to superstardom and was that year's best-selling single in the UK. In 2016 they recorded an updated all-star version for a new generation, focusing on terrorist attacks and gun violence. 8
