This activity is taken from Ten Years of The Tune Into English Roadshow. "Stage directions" are on the left, the spoken words are on the right.

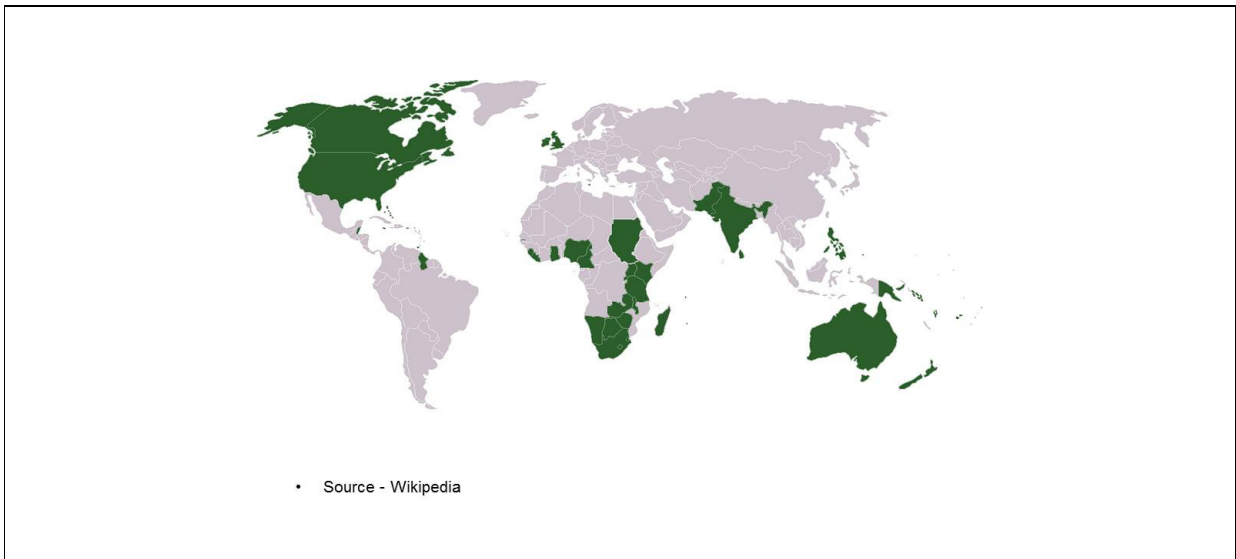
Elicit the word *English*.

Brazil, Morocco, London, Ibiza, L.A., New York, (Las) Vegas, Africa.

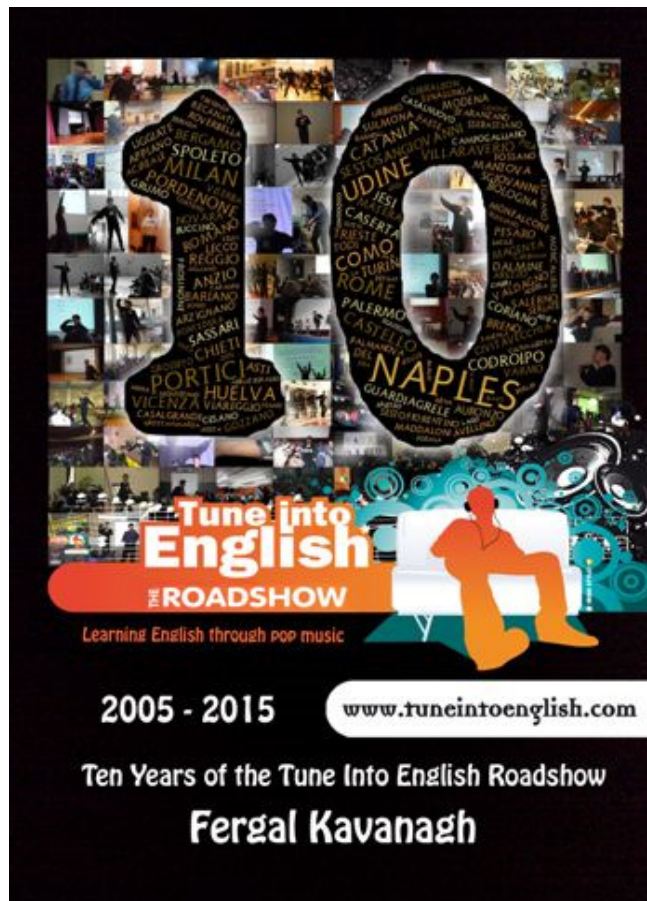
Use fingers to indicate the words as they appear.
