This activity is taken from Ten Years of The Tune Into English Roadshow and was presented in 2013-2014. "Stage directions" are on the left, the spoken words are on the right.

Reveal the next slide bit by bit as you speak.

Today we have some rules...

<u>DO</u>	<u>DON'T</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• sit quietly• agree politely	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• rock the boat• make a mess• push me past the breaking point
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- hold my breath- bite my tongue
	a choice

Elicit where possible.

DO... Sit quietly! Except when you are singing, of course!

I am the teacher, whatever I say is correct.

Even if you don't think so, I want you to agree politely!

DO NOT... make problems, or rock the boat.

DO NOT... make a mess

And do not make me angry and push me past the breaking point!

I will try to be patient, but I don't always succeed...

I will hold my breath and bite my tongue.

But remember you have a choice!

How many rules and phrases are there?

In the next song you will hear all eight, in what order do you hear them?

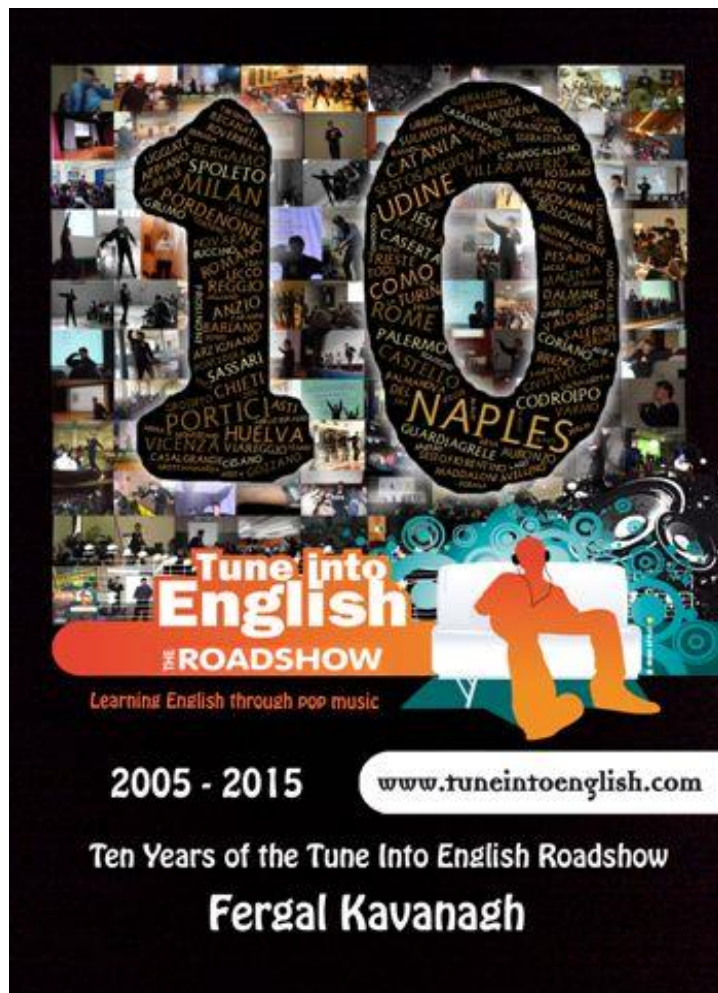
Elicit the number Eight.

Play the first verse of **Roar** by **Katy Perry** (2013), using fingers to indicate each word/phrase as it is played.

Repeat a second time.

The order is: *bite my tongue – hold my breath – rock the boat – make a mess – sit quietly – agree politely – choice – push me past the breaking point.*

Feedback, then sing together with the lyrics projected.
