

## What Does The Fox Say? – Ylvis

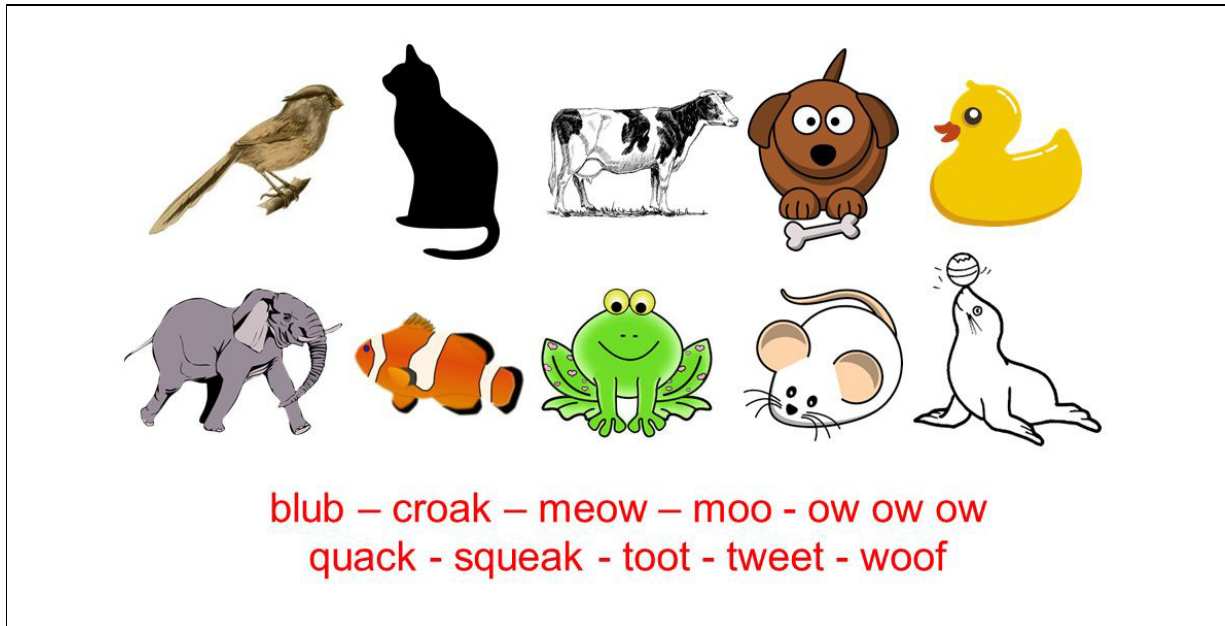
This activity is taken from Ten Years of The Tune Into English Roadshow and was presented in 2013-2014. "Stage directions" are on the left, the spoken words are on the right.

Elicit Lion or Tiger.  
Get them to roar.

Show the animals on the next slide one by one, eliciting their names.

What animal says Roar?  
Can you roar?

Let's look at some animals and the sounds they make.



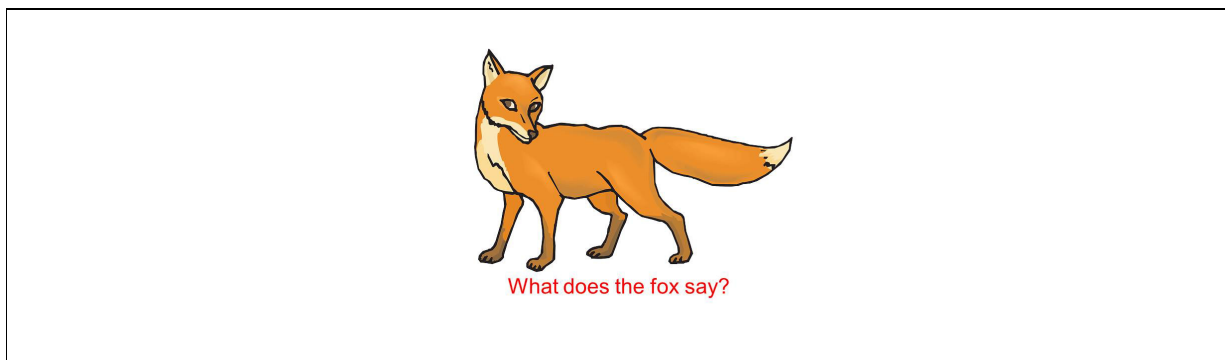
Reveal the final part of the slide.

Show the next slide (without the writing).  
Reveal the title of the song.

Here are the sounds they make.  
Can you each sound to the animal that makes it?

You will hear them all in the next song, in what order do you hear them?

What's this?  
And what does the fox say?













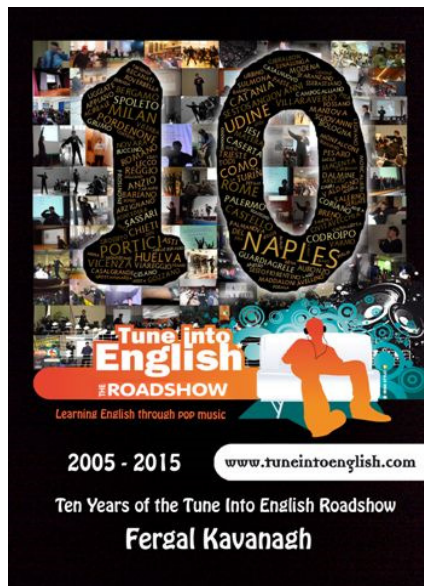
Play the video, with subtitled lyrics, for **What Does The Fox Say?** by **Ylvis** (2013).

Feedback.  
When you elicit the bird sound, show a picture of the Twitter logo.

So, what does the fox say?

What about the other animals?
