- **Note:** This is a very popular Christmas song. There is a karaoke version of it on the Downloadable Worksheets page of the Teacher's Area of www.tuneintoenglish.com

- **Level:** Quarta and Quinta Primaria and Prima Scuola Superiore Inferiore.

- 1) Read the story aloud. Make sure that the students understand the words illustrated in the pictures and any new words.
- 2) Play the song. Students follow it on the worksheet.
- 3) Students do the exercise and then check it together.
- 4) Sing together.
- 5) Follow up: draw a comic strip about Rudolph's story.

- **Level:** Teenagers and Adults.

- 1) Make enough copies of the lyrics for each group of eight students.
- 2) Cut the lyrics into strips. Give each student a one strip.
- 3) Students work together to construct the story, putting the strips in the correct order. (You can ask them to stand in a line holding each strip in the correct order.) Help with vocabulary difficulties.
- 4) Play the song. Students check.
- 5) Correct and sing together.




