

Activity type: gap fill, rhyming words.

Grammar: "would" for a repeated action in the past.

Time: 15 mins.

1. Write the following words on the board:

along - alright - easy - eyes - grown - knowing - me - mine - reach - talking - teach - time - tonight - try - sly - son - surprise - walking

- 2. Match the rhyming pairs

 Note that not all of these are direct rhymes, but follow the phonetic chart:

 /i/ etc.
- 3. Play the song. Students put the words in the correct order, as they hear them.
- 4. Give each student a copy of the worksheet. They should try to insert the missing words, as listed above, in the correct gaps, based on context and the rhymes, as well as on their answers to the previous activity. They can work in alone or in pairs.
- 5. Play the song. Students correct and complete the text.
- 6. Correct, and sing together.

Follow up: Many years later the singer meets the protagonist of the song at a party. Imagine their conversation.
