Talk - Coldplay - Notes

- Activity type: gap fill, listening for specific words.
- Time: 20 mins.
- Note: This is taken from Coldplay's 2005 album "X&Y", and is based around the riff of the Kraftwerk song "Computer Love". The band were initially unhappy with song, but eventually decided to include it on the album – the song was subsequently nominated for a 2007 Grammy Award.

Pre-listening activity:

1) Ask students if they know the band Coldplay. Elicit a list of the band's hits.

While-listening activities:

- 2) Play the instrumental introduction to the song (the first 37 seconds). Let students guess the name of the song.
- 3) Give each student a copy of the worksheet. Play the first part of the song students complete Exercise 1).
- 4) Play the Chorus students complete Exercise 2).
- 5) Play the next verse students complete Exercise 3). If they need help you can point out that each segment is half a line the first part of each line begins with a capital letter, the second part with a small letter.
- 6) Play the Chorus (the next part of the song) students complete Exercise 4). Note that this is the same as Exercise 2) and is repeated here as there are some slight difference in the lyrics.
- 7) Students complete Exercise 5), then play the final verse.
- 8) Play the complete song again. Students check their answers to the previous exercises and follow the lyrics.
- 9) Sing the song together.
