
# Waterloo – ABBA – Notes

- Activity types: Vocabulary (definitions crossword), listening for specific words, gap fill, reporting and writing biographies
- Level: Pre-Intermediate/Intermediate
- Grammar Focus: Grammar Review
- **Notes:** This is the first single from Swedish pop group ABBA's second album, *Waterloo*, and the first single to be credited as "ABBA". The song won the 1974 Eurovision Song Contest.

The title refers to a historical event: in the song a girl is about to surrender to a love story, just as Napoleon had to surrender at the Battle of Waterloo in 1815.

**1.** Give each student a folded copy of the worksheet and ask them to complete the crossword in Activity 1, individually or in pairs/groups.



**2.** Play the song. Ask students to listen for the words from the previous activity and tick them as they hear them.

## **KEY:** See complete version of the song

- **3.** Feedback, then students unfold the page and fill in the gaps with the missing words, based on their answers to the previous activity and context.
- **4.** Play the song again. Students check their answers in pairs or in groups, then correct in open class and sing together!


# FOLLOW UP:
